EXPRESSIVE WRITING

WRITING IN THE FIRST PERSON

WRITE A STORY WITH ONE OF THE FOLLOWING TITLES:

- A. Write about a time when you were ashamed of yourself.
- B. Write a story beginning with: 'I kept hoping she/he would phone me back but.....'
- C. Write a story about when you had to wear an outfit you hated.
- D. Write a story about a time when you managed to do something for the first time.

Ideally the story will be true and personal, or sound true at least ie: no aliens or things which don't sound real.

It is best if you choose one that links to a hobby or something that interests you. The story needs a plot and be about real life situations. A story requires a beginning, middle and end. Using your five senses helps add realistic descriptions of situations and with detail.
